FERC Regulatory Process:

Initiate Pre-filing Environmental Review



Conduct scoping to determine environmental issues and attempt to resolve issues



Applicant files FERC application



FERC issues Notice of Application



FERC Issues Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)



FERC responds to environmental comments & FERC issues final **Environmental Assessment**

Before Pre-Filing



The goal of outreach at this stage is twofold:

- We make energy happen.™
- 1. To educate the local officials about the company's efforts to design a project that meets the growing needs of customers and the region while minimizing environmental and public impacts;
- Notify local officials of upcoming field activities in the project area and timelines for those activities.
- Project briefings
- Educate county and local officials, environmental advocacy groups, community leaders and other identified stakeholders about:
 - Our company.
 - The advantages of natural gas as a clean energy solution.
 - The methods used to build and/or expand natural gas pipeline systems.
 - The scope of the project and early identification of potential routes.
 - The company's preliminary plans to meet customer requests through the proposed facility additions and any necessary modifications to existing facilities.
 - The regulatory process and major project milestones.
 - Opportunities for public input and how the company utilizes that input.
 - Other key messages as defined by the team.
